ORDINANCE NO. 19-01**

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS

On January 22, 2018, the Onondaga Township Board adopted Ordinance No. 19-01, the Onondaga Township Prohibition of Marihuana Establishments Ordinance, pursuant to the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act, MCL 333.27951, *et seq.*, which prohibits all marihuana establishments within the Township, in order to maintain the public health, safety and welfare of Onondaga Township.

The Ordinance contains the following sections and catch lines: Section 1: Title; Section 2: Intent and Purpose; Section 3: Definitions; Section 4: No Marihuana Establishments; Section 5: Violations and Penalties; Section 6: Severability; Section 7: Repeal; and Section 8: Effective Date. This Ordinance will become effective thirty (30) days after this publication.
